

THE GREAT FEAST DAYS ARE HERE: We are in the middle of those Sundays that are the truly great themes of Catholic life. Today's Feast of Pentecost in which we celebrate the descent of the Most Holy Spirit (the Advocate promised and sent by Jesus) is also the birthday of the Church. Today also concludes the Paschal period of Easter, reflected in the last featured appearance of the lighted Paschal Candle this day. From tomorrow, the Paschal Candle will be returned to its traditional position in proximity to the baptismal font. We also return to Ordinary Time from tomorrow!

Next Sunday is the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity in which we are reminded of the obligation for us to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation between Ash Wednesday and Trinity Sunday. Failure to abide by that obligation carries with it the taint of serious sin. So, it has to be action time for those who have yet to fulfil this obligation!

Tomorrow (Monday 25 May) is also the Solemnity Feast of Our Lady Help of Christians. While there will be no Mass in this parish, Mass will be available for those interested, at St Canice's Katoomba at 10.00am. You should also know that the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary that falls next Sunday (31 May) has not been transferred to another date and so will not be celebrated in its own right this year.

The Solemnity Feast of Corpus Christi – the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ – falls on Sunday week, 7 June.

CATECHISTS' COMMISSIONING: Following today's homily, our Special Religious Education Ministers will be formally commissioned into the roles they have within the three public schools within our Parish – Blackheath, Mt Victoria and Megalong Valley. In association with that commissioning, there is an opportunity for each parishioner also to make a commitment to support this community through its special ministers. To that end, the following liturgy will form part of the Rite of Commissioning:

Commitment of the Community

Celebrant: My brothers and sisters, realising that we all share in this ministry of Special Religious Education, do you pledge your support for these parishioners of ours called by God from out of our midst and commissioned by us as SREs in our Parish religious education programme?

Community: We do.

Celebrant: Will you endeavour through prayer and witness to be ministers of God's Word to each other so that we may grow together in sharing in this work of the Lord?

Community: We will.

Celebrant: Let us continue with our liturgy, seeking our Father's blessing on this work which we undertake.

Community: Amen.


