

CHANGE OF FOCUS: October to November: Tuesday marks the end of Mother Mary's month of the Rosary, while Wednesday introduces the very special month of November when we apply our thoughts and prayers to the welfare of our dearly departed loved ones. This month starts off on a high with the Solemnity Feast of All Saints; not just that one day in the year when we publicly acknowledge, fete and honour the great saints who have trodden this earth, but every saint in heaven including those completely unknown to us. Wednesday's normal 9.00am Mass will honour this great feast of All Saints!

Thursday is All Souls Day, that day each year when we expressly commemorate all the faithful departed, including our brothers and sisters suffering the torments of Purgatory. We are able to assist them through the 'Communion of Saints' that binds us together in a relationship of love that bypasses the temporal life barrier which otherwise exists between us.

Also, from Wednesday, the usual Remembrance Book will be in place adjoining the baptismal font for parishioners to list the names of their departed loved ones. We do this so that our community may honour them in our prayers throughout November. Additionally, should you so desire, you could place their name in the basket provided in front of the altar, there to remain until the end of the month. Blank cards for this purpose will be available next to the Remembrance Book. Again, special envelopes will be available for those wanting to have individual mention made in Masses celebrated in honour of loved ones this coming month.

Your prayers are particularly requested during the month for those parishioners who have departed this life since our last All Souls' Day. Included in that number are those for whom I have conducted requiem services. They are *Therese Devereaux, Juagan Kallen, Margaret (Rita) Jenner, Kenneth Kirkham, Mignon Spessot, Edward Cocksedge and Barry Roberts.* Additionally, there are another seven deceased from other areas whose funerals I have also conducted during this period. Please direct some of your prayers to all fourteen of these deceased brothers and sisters and their families.

ANNUAL AUDIT RESULTS: The Diocesan 2016-17 financial audit has now been finalized with the same extraordinary accuracy achieved by Parish Secretary Marilyn Rowe for every one of the nine years that have passed since my arrival. Congratulations from all of us Marilyn on achieving such high standards, many times under very stressful operating conditions, indeed!

While on this subject, I have to report that the Operating Profit for the audited year is 2,535.94 (27% above last year), while the Net Profit is 3,456.38 (52.5% +) – both within planned performance limits! A wonderful result for our Sacred Heart Parish!

THE EPIPHANY PILGRIMAGE: Are you looking for a different way to start the new year? The Epiphany Pilgrimage is a 7 day, 110km Catholic pilgrimage through the Blue Mountains which coincides with the Feast of the Epiphany in early January. The pilgrimage begins at Our Lady of the Way Parish in Emu Plains on January 2 and finishes at the site of the Chapel of the Magi at the top of the mountains in Bell on January 8. Throughout the journey, pilgrims walk through the beautiful Blue Mountains bushland including many of the lesser known tracks and engage in daily Mass and Adoration at each of the six parishes along the route where they also stay and offer prayers and petitions for the needs of the Catholic community throughout Australia and the world.
