FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT (Theme - 'Expectation'): Today we begin the Season of Advent, a four week period in preparation for Christmas. For many people this will be a time of shopping and parties, normal habits for this time of year - just as in the days before the Great Flood when "people were eating, drinking, taking wives...then the flood came and swept all away". It is so easy to be consumed in the day-to-day events, in pleasures, in the immediate concerns of living. One year leads to another year, and another and another...it can all become a little bit meaningless. For us Christians though, we prepare to celebrate the birth of Christ. God has come to us, lived with us, taught us how to live and then died for us. In Advent we, too, are reminded of that one day when Christ will return. So we also prepare for that to arrive. Christians, too, are engaged in the shopping and partying, but it is all for a special purpose. We are spiritual, not just material beings, and we are on a journey of continuing spiritual growth. We look for Christ in our daily lives and seek to follow him. So may this be a blessed season for all as we journey towards the Kingdom of God. This week, see if you can devote a little more time for reflection and prayer, and experience the joy and peace the Babe of Bethlehem brings at Christmas. Today, the Advent Wreath will be used for the first time this year, led at the beginning of each Mass by a parish family who will introduce each week's prayer for us to share.

Week 1 - Lighting of the purple candle: From Isaiah we read, "The people who walk in darkness have seen a great light." God of compassion, be with us as we prepare and wait for the birth of your Son, Jesus. As the candle is lit: Let this candle remind us that Jesus is coming."

THE ADVENT WREATH: The circle of the wreath and the evergreens that make it up both signify God's endless mercy and undying love. Three purple candles and one rose-coloured (pink) candle are evenly spaced around the wreath. There is one larger white candle in the centre of the wreath. Each week, an additional candle is lit. As the light grows brighter each week, we are reminded that the Light of the world will soon arrive in glory. The central white candle is a recent addition to the Advent Wreath. It signifies the Light of Christ, and is first lit on Christmas Eve and then re-lit on Christmas Day.

VINNIES CHRISTMAS APPEAL: St Vincent de Paul Society Sacred Heart Blackheath Conference is humbled, and the people we assist are blessed by the generosity of this Parish. Between July 2016 to March 2017, almost 60% of the people we assisted were in housing stress, where their rent takes up more than 30% of their income.
