


### The Sacred Heart of Jesus Year B

MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS FEAST: As stated in last week's Bulletin, we are today celebrating our Patronal Feast – that of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. We also celebrated this Feast on its proper day, last Friday (8 June), that being the 17th day after Pentecost Sunday, which confirms for us that this Feast Day of the Most Sacred Heart is a variable feast dependant on the fall of Easter Sunday that is itself dependant on the moon cycle for any particular year. However, because the Sacred Heart Feast always occurs on a Friday when there are fewer people at Mass, I have again taken a decision to also celebrate this day over the adjoining weekend - both Vigil (Saturday) and today's 9,30am Sunday Mass. After all, Jesus in the form of His Most Sacred Heart is the Patron of our parish. So, we want to ensure that as many people as possible should have an opportunity to honour Him in this special way. Hence the change to today's Mass theme!. The Mass itself will include the same readings used for the original feast last Friday.

I note, too, that at vesterday's morning Mass (Saturday) the complementary Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary was shared by all who attended. Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament, recitation of the rosary and Benediction were included in that celebration.
